Classroom Management Software

The Netop TeachPad is a hardware accessory that plugs into the USB port on the teacher's computer and performs the basic functions of School classroom management in any classroom where School version 6.2 or higher is installed.

Before plugging the TeachPad into the teacher's computer, Netop School6 classroom management software must be installed on both the teacher's computer and on the student computers. You must also have a class set up in School so the TeachPad knows which computers to interact with.

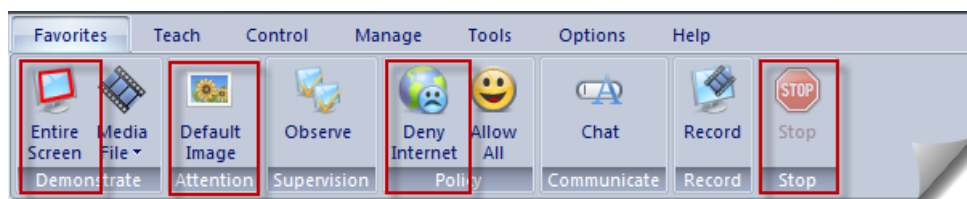
If you have not set up a class, refer to the Netop School User's Guide or the product help.



Once School has been installed successfully and teacher and student modules are running, simply connect the USB plug to the teacher's computer.

Using the Netop TeachPad

If you have used School6 in your classroom, the functions of the TeachPad will be familiar to you as each of the five keys on the TeachPad matches a button in the teacher module.



Using the TeachPad adds to your flexibility and mobility in that you do not have to sit down at your computer and perform precise mouse-click.

- Note that when a TeachPad button is used, the corresponding command is applied to ALL student computers.

My Classroom

A single press of the **My Classroom** button on the TeachPad corresponds to several mouse clicks in Netop School: the teacher module is maximized in thumbnails view and the **Rejoin** command (on the **Manage** tab) is applied.

Tip: This could be useful when you have not used the computer for a while and the screen saver has taken over or if you have minimized the teacher module while working on something else. A single key press shows student computer thumbnails and provides an overview of the classroom in an instant.

Pressing the **My Classroom** button a second time minimizes the teacher module.

Demo

Pressing the **Demo** button on the TeachPad corresponds to clicking the **Entire Screen** button in the teacher module.

To stop a demo, use the **Stop** button.

Blank

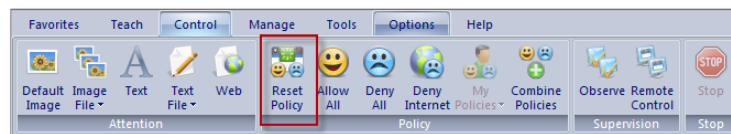
Pressing the **Blank** button on the TeachPad corresponds to clicking the **Default Image** button to get the students' attention.

Pressing the **Blank** button a second time corresponds clicking the **Default Image** a second time and has the effect that the attention image is removed.

Surf-Lock

Pressing the **Surf-Lock** button on the TeachPad corresponds to clicking the **Deny Internet** button in the teacher module.

Pressing the **Surf-Lock** button a second time corresponds to clicking the **Reset Policy** button on the **Control** tab.



Stop

Pressing the **Stop** button on the TeachPad stops any demo which is currently running, regardless of whether it was started from the teacher module or using the TeachPad.
